## **Center School at Home Middle School Behavioral Expectations**

While in school, you are expected to follow the Three R's of Learning: We are **R**espectful, We are **R**esponsible, We are **R**eady to Learn. In keeping with that theme, there are also expectations to follow when learning in a virtual environment. Adhering to these guidelines will help to ensure a successful learning experience during your online instructional time.

### **We are Respectful**

1. Speak with respect to your teacher and classmates. Raise your hand to speak or use the "raise hand" icon.
2. Remain focused and engaged. When asked a question, respond.
3. You **MAY NOT** meet for class in your bed.
4. Your work area should be at a desk or table, free of distractions.
5. Do not eat during class. You may have a water bottle with you.
6. Dress appropriately (no hoodies on heads; shirts on), and practice good hygiene. Comb or brush your hair.

### **We are Responsible**

1. You are required to attend every online class.
2. Sign into class five minutes early. Your teacher should not be waiting for you.
3. Make sure all of your work is complete before class begins.
4. Make sure that you have had breakfast before your morning classes and have had lunch before your afternoon classes.

### **We are Ready to Learn**

1. Have all materials ready for each class including homework, classwork papers, and writing utensils.
2. It is encouraged that you keep your video on so that your teacher can see you. It helps enhance your learning experience.
3. Have a small fidget (not a toy) with you to increase focus and attention. You may sit and stand during instructional time so long as you are not distracting others.
4. Students should only have Zoom open or other sites as directed by the teacher during instructional time.
